## Quick Guide

### Download

Get EverRiseUI.zip from the EverRise  
Network footer

Replace banners & edit ad-config.json

Upload dist/ to Netlify, Arweave, or your host

## Quick Guide — 3 Steps

1

### Download the website interface files

Scroll to the bottom of the EverRise Network page.  
Find the “**Download website**” link in the footer — or click any ad banner — to download EverRiseUI.zip.

2

### Customise ad banners (optional)

Unzip **EverRiseUI.zip** → open dist/ folder → replace banner images (**1200×150-banner png**).  
Open **ad-config.json** and update: "image" (filename), "link" (click URL), "alt" (description).

3

### Deploy

- Netlify / Arweave: drag and drop the entire dist/ folder.
- Personal hosting (cPanel/FTP): upload the contents INSIDE dist/ to your public root (e.g. public\_html).

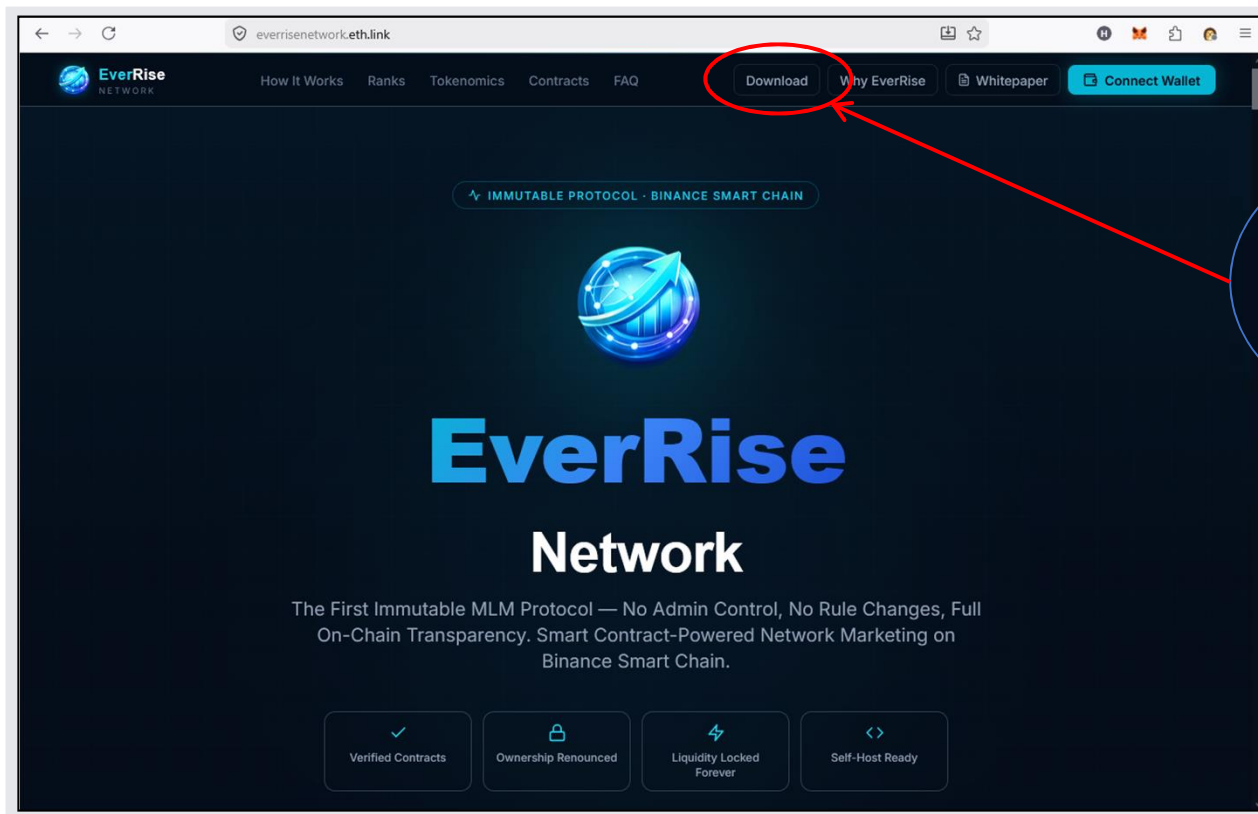

## Download the website interface files


Scroll to the top of the EverRise Network page.

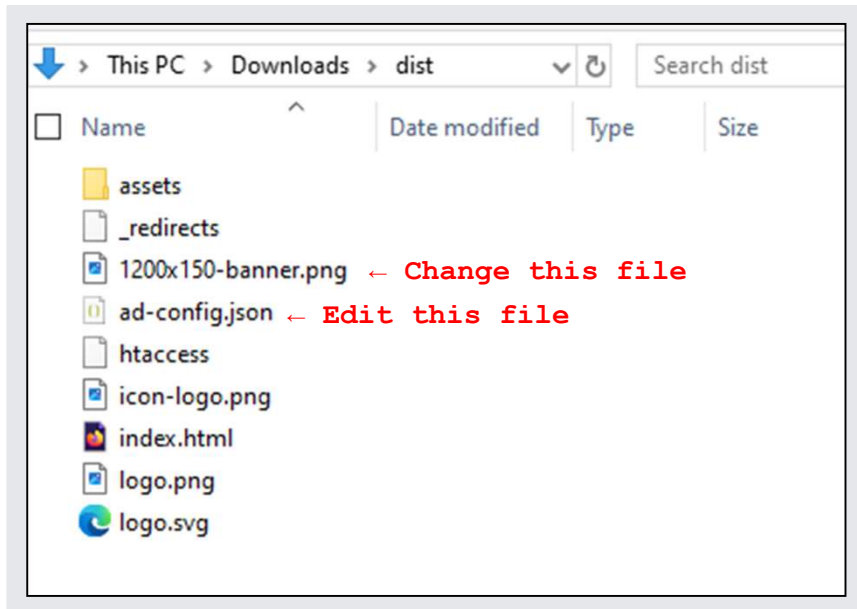

## 2 Customise ad banners (optional)

### Contents of dist/

After unzipping EverRiseUI.zip, the dist/ folder contains:



### A Prepare your banner image

Property	Value	Notes
Dimensions	1200 × 150 px	Wide banner format
Format	PNG or JPG	PNG supports transparency
File size	Under 200 KB	Keeps page load fast
Location	Inside dist/	Same level as index.html

💡 You can use Canva, Photoshop, or any design tool to create your banner. Export as PNG or JPG.

### B Open ad-config.json in a text editor

OS	Editor	How to open
Windows	Notepad++ (free)	Right-click file → Open with → Notepad++
Windows	VS Code (free)	Right-click → Open with Code
macOS	TextEdit / VS Code	Right-click → Open With → TextEdit
Any	Any text editor	Drag the file into the editor window

## 2 Customise ad banners (optional)

Field	What it controls
"enabled"	true = show ads / false = hide all ads
"image"	Banner file path inside dist/ (start with /)
"link"	URL opened when visitor clicks the banner
"alt"	Short description text (good for SEO)

## C Edit ad-config.json and save

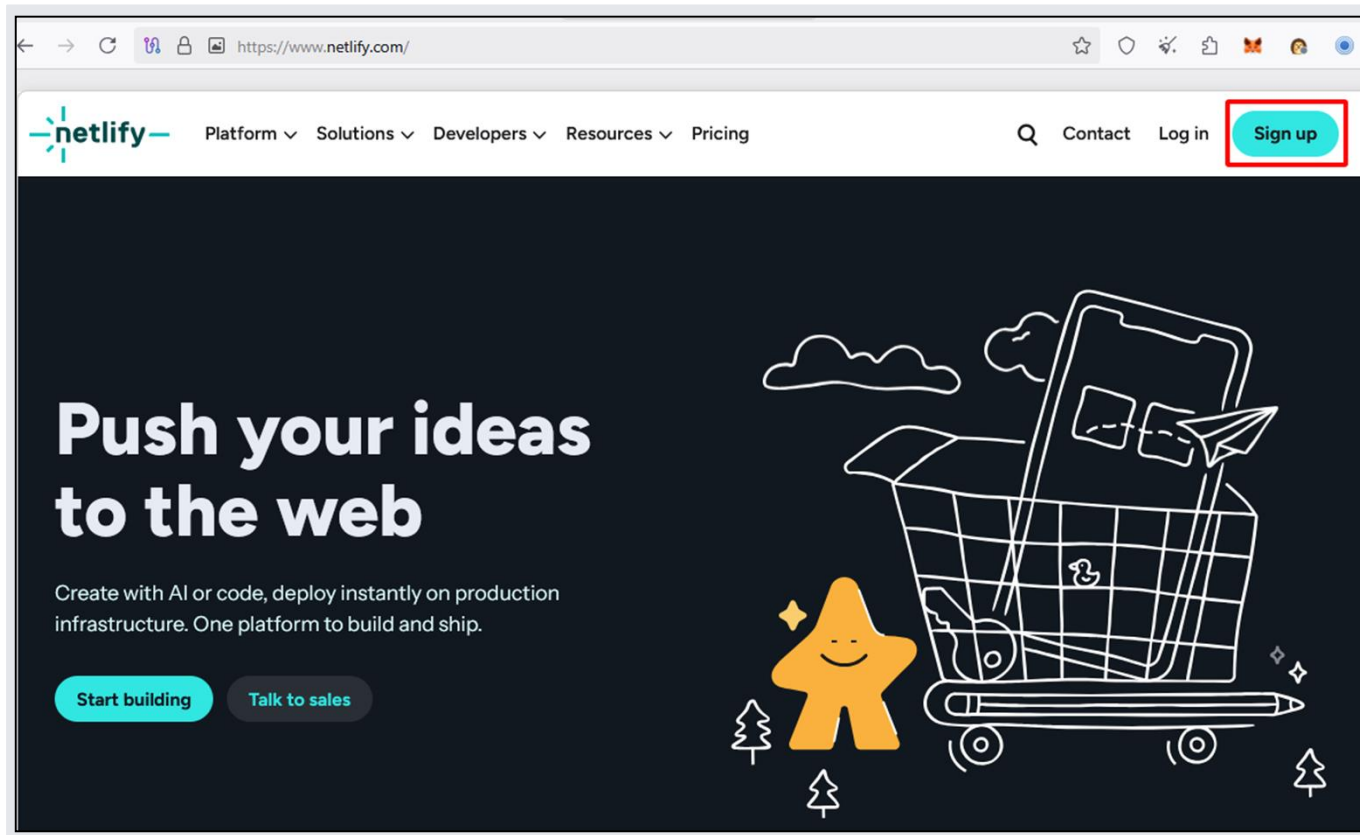

💡 Add more banners by duplicating the { ... } block and separating entries with a comma. Set "enabled": false to hide all ads without deleting your configuration.

⚠️ Save the file with Ctrl+S (Windows) or Cmd+S (macOS). If the site shows no ads after re-deploying, paste your JSON into [jsonlint.com](https://jsonlint.com) to check for syntax errors.

## Sign up Netlify account


- 3 Open <https://www.netlify.com> in your browser. Click the **Sign up** button in the top-right corner of the page.

## Choose a sign-up method

Select Google, GitHub, GitLab, or Bitbucket if you have those accounts. Otherwise click Sign up with email at the bottom of the list.



## Enter email & password, click Sign up

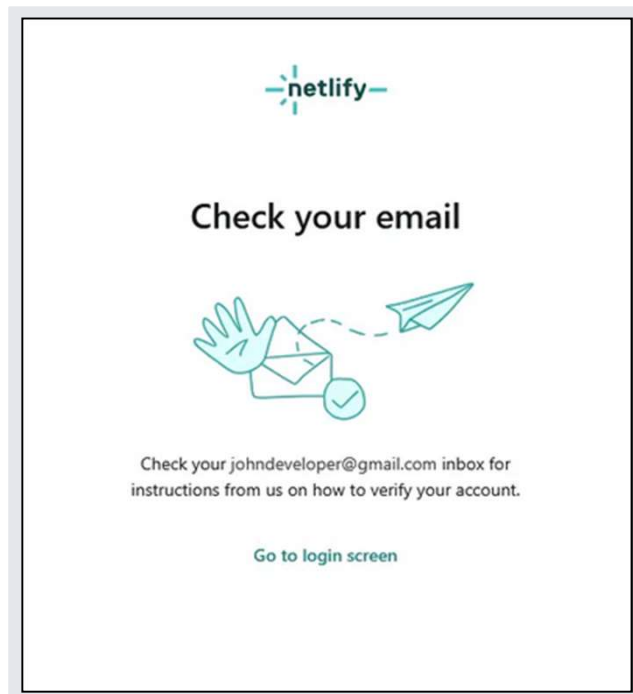
- ① Type your email address

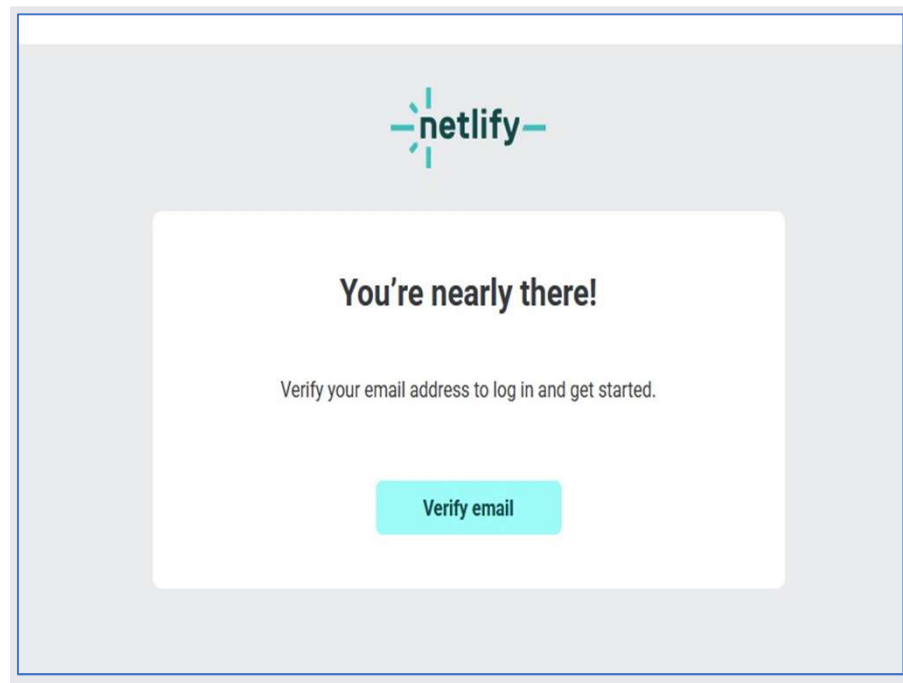
## 6 Check your inbox for the confirmation email

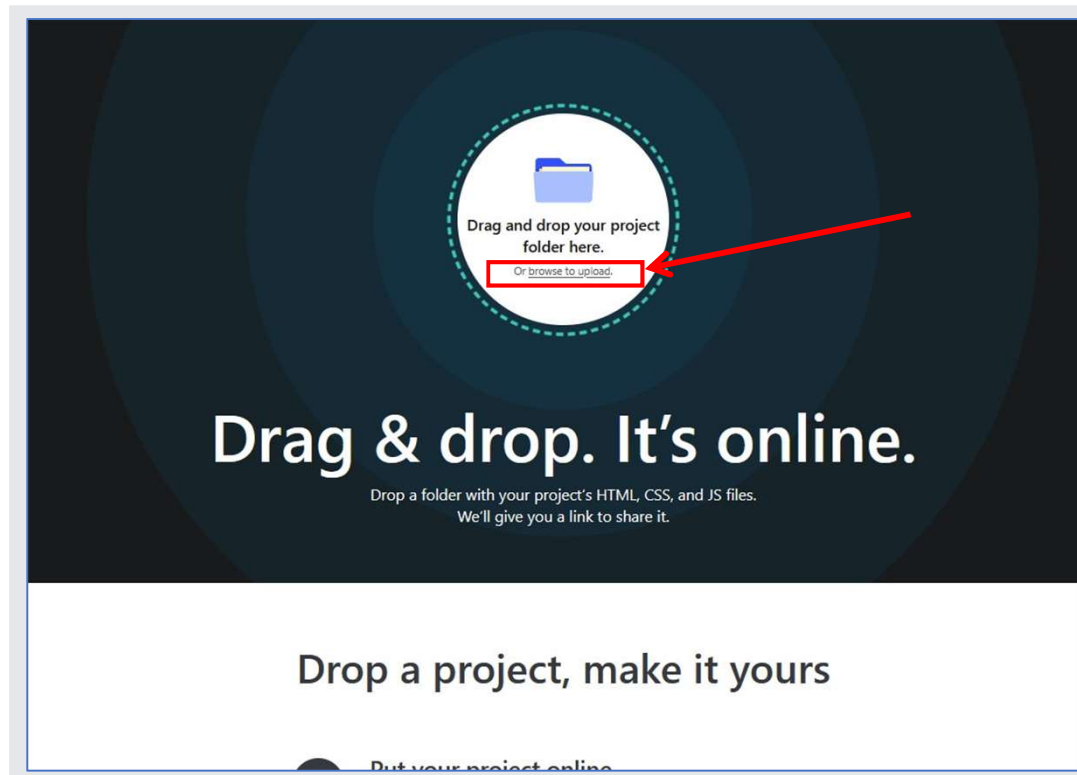

## 10 Drag your dist/ folder onto Netlify Drop

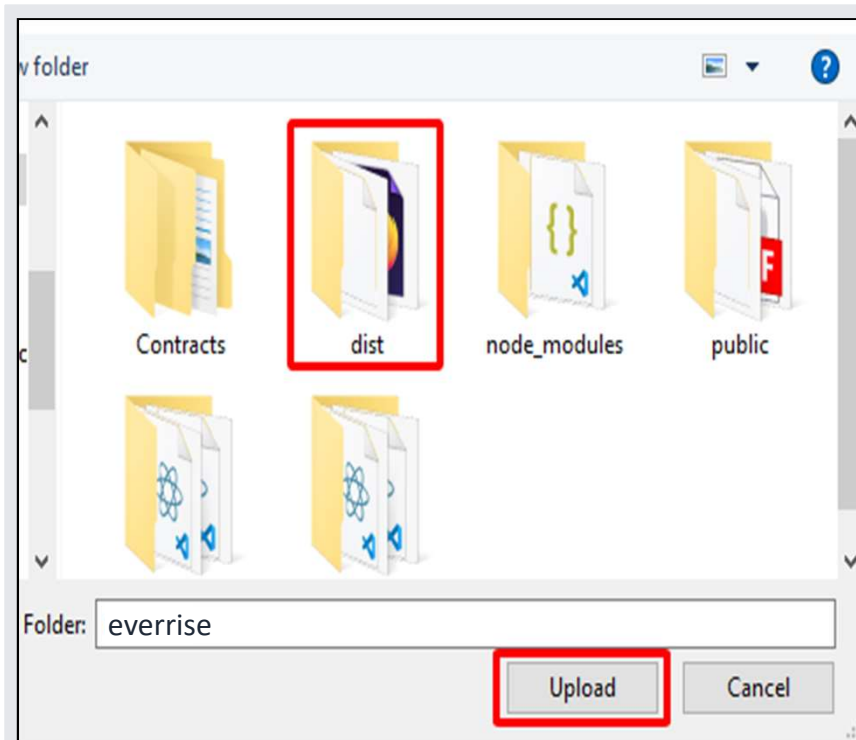
Option A — drag & drop: Open File Explorer, locate the dist/ folder, drag it onto the circle on the Netlify Drop page.

Option B — browse: Click "**browse to upload**" and select the dist/ folder.



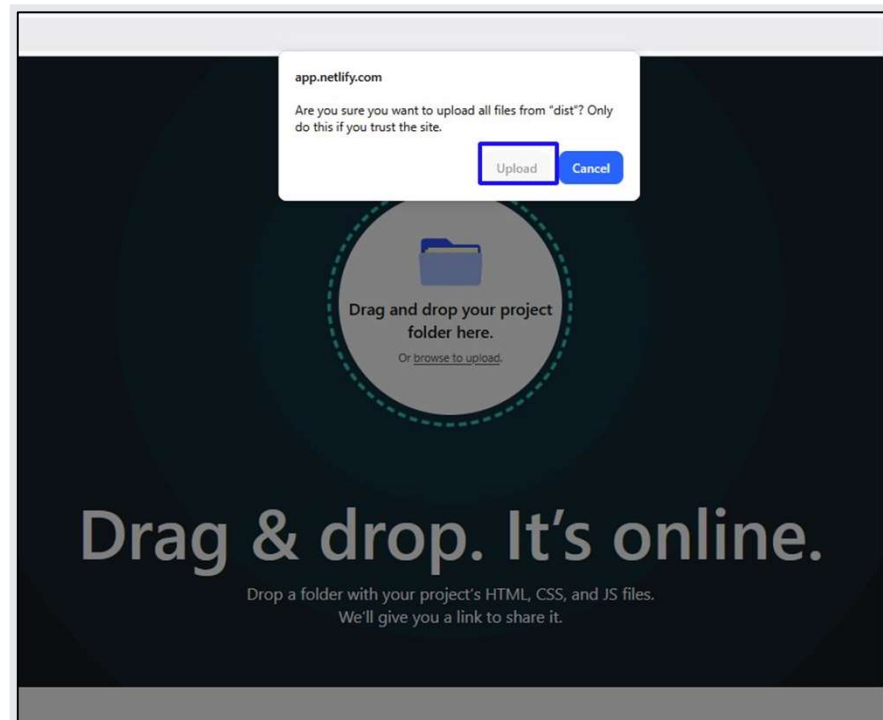
## 11 Select the "dist" folder and click Upload

If you used Option B (browse), a file-picker dialog opens. Click once on the **dist** folder to select it, then click **Upload**.



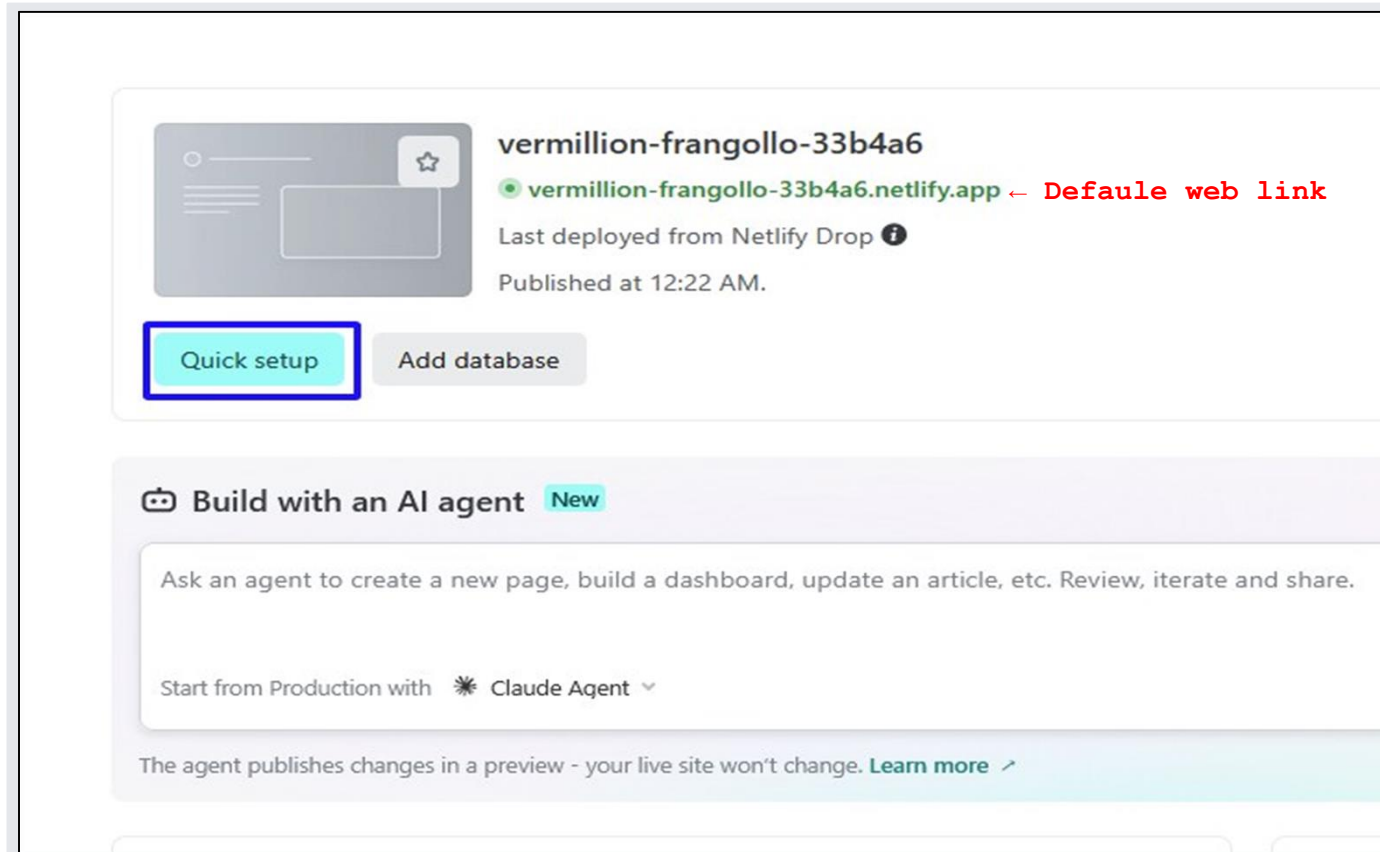
## 12 Confirm the upload in the browser dialog

Your browser will show a security prompt asking if you trust the site. Click **Upload** to proceed.



## 13 Deploy successful — copy your URL

After 20–60 seconds Netlify finishes and shows your live URL in green. Copy it and open in a new tab to check your site. To rename, click **Quick setup**.



## 14 Set a custom project name

Type your preferred name in the Project name field. Only letters, numbers, and hyphens are allowed. The URL preview updates as you type (ex: **everrise.netlify.app**). Click Update project name to save.

The project name determines the default URL of your project – make it your own! Only alphanumeric characters and single hyphens allowed.

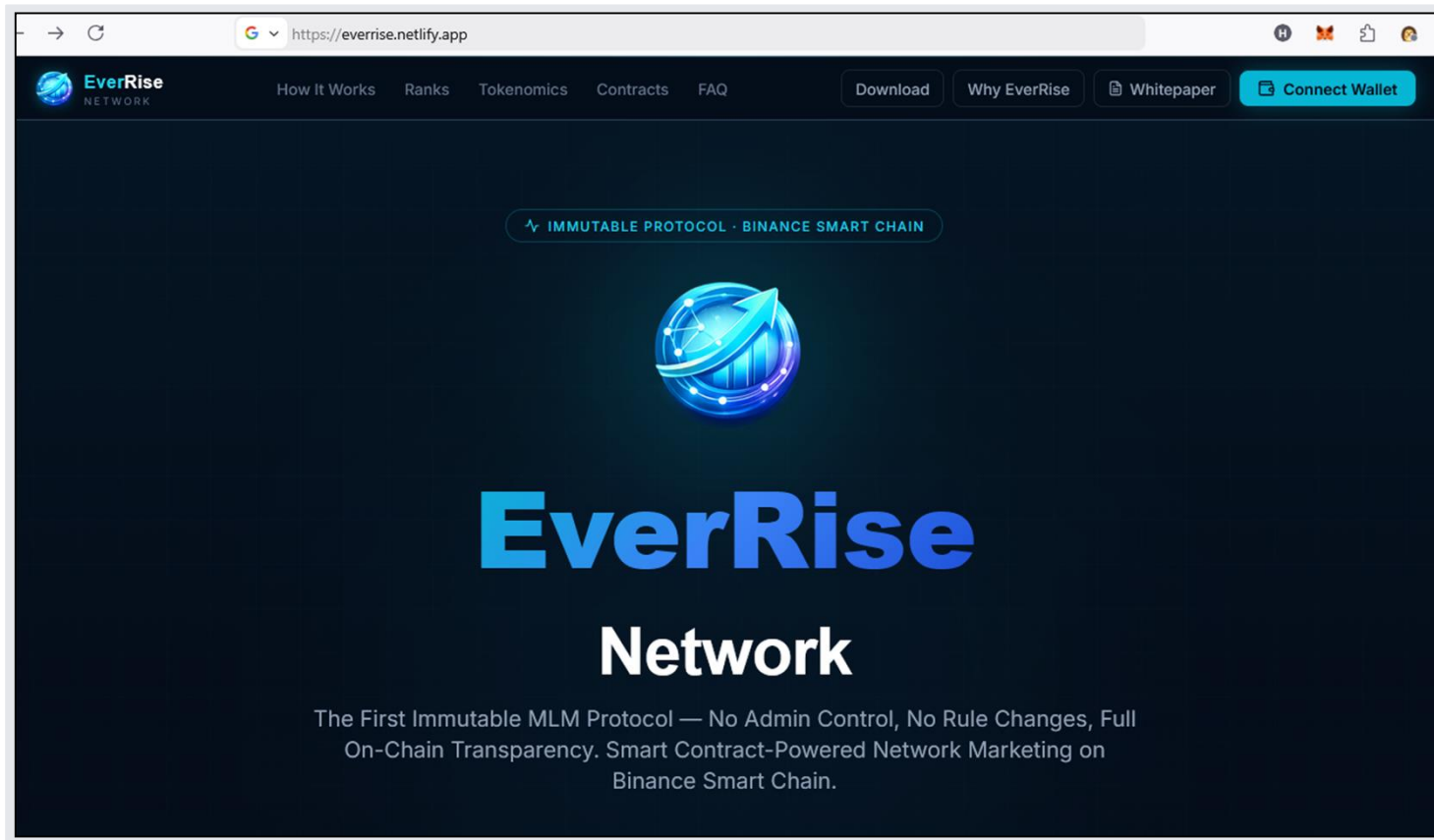
